History & sightseeing

The history of the city of Heidelberg dates back to 500 BC to the time of the Celts. Numerous historical buildings including churches still stand as witnesses to the city's development and the picturesque old town quarter invites you to come and visit. Heidelberg's Ruprecht-Karls-Universität counts as one of the oldest universities in the world and is internationally renowned for its research successes in the area of medicine as well as for its academic excellence.

Climate & temperatures

The region generally enjoys a mild climate the whole year through. Particularly during the summer months, Heidelberg and the surrounding area enjoy comfortably warm temperatures – outdoor activities are therefore possible until well into the evening without the need for warmer clothing. The city offers a diverse gastronomic and cultural palette. Many sights of interest around Heidelberg are also reachable on foot.

Traffic & accessibility

By car, you can easily reach Heidelberg via the B3, the B37 and the A5. Furthermore, the city has a main train station, situated in the direct vicinity of the Bahnstadt-Heidelberg quarter. The city is also linked to four "Ferienstraßen" (picturesque tourist routes).

Thanks to the city's good connections, numerous neighbouring towns are easily and quickly within reach for shopping trips, tourist attractions and sightseeing purposes.

In addition to the health centre itself, the area in which it was built is equally impressive – the salutem clinic is one of numerous newly built, highly modern buildings within Heidelberg's new Bahnstadt quarter. Within the framework of local urban development, a new living and working environment has been created here for several thousand people.

Everyday life, leisure & culture

What was once wasteland has now become a lively quarter that offers its inhabitants maximum life-quality. The town quarter thrives on its short distances – no matter where you want to go. Daily tasks such as shopping, playground visits, taking part in leisure activities or visiting cultural facilities are all possible on foot. This proximity aspect is strengthened by the excellent traffic connections – by car as well as on public transport, the Bahnstadt quarter is perfectly connected and easy to reach.

Science & research

Life and work, economy and research – this town quarter combines all these aspects. Here you will find commercial premises as well as trading companies and service enterprises in the direct vicinity of the Bahnstadt campus. Research has its home here: together with science-related companies, technologies are developed for the most diverse future-focused industries. Biotechnological developments alongside further areas, ranging from information technology and communications technology to energy and environmental sciences, are the focus here.

Architecture & sustainability

From the salutem clinic Heidelberg to the "Westarkaden" and residential buildings – the town quarter is not only conspicuous for its unique flair, but also for its urban planning standards. Here, timelessly beautiful and appealing architecture meets the highest energy standards – the town quarter counts as one of the largest passive-house settlements in the world. The unusually high energy efficiency of the quarter's buildings and households forms the basis for energy needs to be completely met by renewable energy sources.

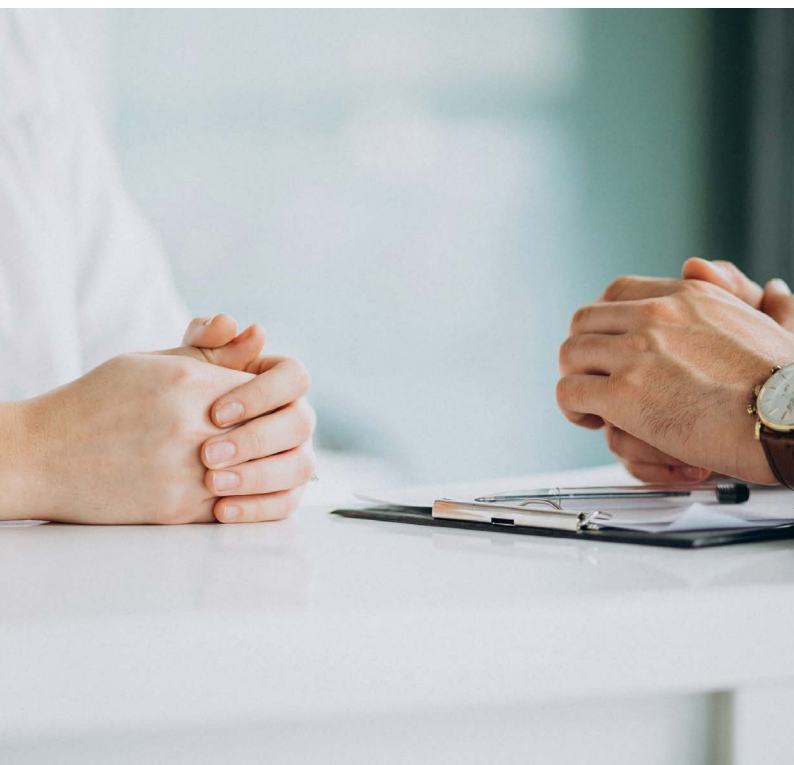
